

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PLYMPTON-WYOMING

BY-LAW NUMBER 29 OF 2001

BEING a by-law for regulating and prohibiting within the Town of Plympton-Wyoming, noise or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, Section 210 (138) and Section 210 (140) provide that a municipality may pass by-laws for prohibiting or regulating within the municipality, unusual noise or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants and for prohibiting and abating public nuisances.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming deems it advisable to pass such a by-law.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming hereby enacts as follows:

1. No person who has the care, custody or control of a dog within the Town of Plympton-Wyoming shall permit such dog to indulge in unreasonable or unnecessary yelping, howling, barking or other sounds in the Town of Plympton-Wyoming during any hours of the day or night.
2. Penalties
 - (a) Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offense and in addition to any other penalty which may be applicable thereto, is liable to such fines as are prescribed by the Provincial Offences Act.
 - (b) Notwithstanding all other provisions of the by-law in respect to penalties for violation of the provisions of this by-law, any person may, upon presentation of a violation tag issued alleging commission of such offense under this by-law, pay at the Plympton-Wyoming Municipal Office within fifteen (15) days from the date of such tag, a penalty of \$50.00 and upon such payment no further proceedings shall be taken under this by-law in respect to the said offense alleged in the violation tag.
3. The Municipal Law Enforcement Officer or Officers duly appointed by the Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming shall enforce the provisions of the by-law.
4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.
