**Town of Plympton-Wyoming Activated Emergency Control Group
and Limited Access / Closures of Facilities**

WYOMING, ON – The Town of Plympton-Wyoming Emergency Control Group met on Monday, March 16th at 4 p.m. via teleconference to review the state of COVID-19 and discuss updates from the province and Public Health. For the most up to date information, please visit the Lambton Public Health website or the Province of Ontario website.

The Control Group will continue to meet daily via teleconference for the foreseeable future to review the current state of events. The Control Group has directed the activation of the Towns Emergency Control Plan; a declaration of a state of emergency has not formally been made, however discussions about this will be taking place over the coming week.

Currently, the following closures and restrictions at Towns facilities are in place, effective Monday, March 16, 2020:

- The Camlachie Community Centre and Old Plympton Township Hall are closed until further notice.
- The Plympton-Wyoming Town Office is open for staff but closed to the public.

Payments for taxes and water can be made in the drop box (cash or cheque) at the front of the Municipal Office or online. Staff is available to accept phone calls in the office at this time.
