### DO YOU QUALIFY FOR THE SENIOR'S LOW INCOME PROPERTY TAX CREDIT?

To qualify—you must own your principal residence in Plympton-Wyoming and receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement. The deadline to apply for property tax credit is March 31st each year. Two-hundred dollars (\$200.00) is applied as a credit to your tax account. Contact Christine Joosten, Deputy Treasurer for more information or with any questions.

# PLYMPTON-WYOMING FIRE DEPARTMENT

Inspect your barn and outbuildings for fire hazards to reduce the risk of tragic loss.

## Barn Fire Safety Checklist

- Heat lamps and space heaters are kept at a safe distance from anything that can burn.
- All wiring is free from damage.
- Heaters are on a sturdy surface and cannot fall over.
- Extension cords are not used in the barn.
- Lightbulbs have covers to protect them from dust, moisture and breakage.
- Feed, hay and straw and flammable liquids are stored away from the main barn.
- Workers are trained to use fire extinguishers.
- Damage is identified quickly and repairs are completed with safety in mind.
- The barn is a smoke-free zone.

# The Town Of PLYMPTON-WYOMING



**Yard Waste** consists of leaves, grass and garden plant material only.

No sticks or brush in paper bags.

Leaf waste must be in paper bags or a container (no lid) marked with an "X" on both sides.

Bags and containers cannot weigh more than 50 pounds.

Yard waste pick-up is every Friday in October and November in the former Village of Wyoming only. Please have all articles out to the road before 7:00 a.m.

Transco Recycling will also accept yard waste from all Plympton-Wyoming residents at no charge with proof of residency.

## Things to remember on Garbage Day

Each household is allowed to place 1 large item a week out with your garbage. Ensure all items that contain freon are tagged that the freon has been removed by a licensed professional.

Have all garbage and / or recycling out to the road before 7:00 a.m.

Have a designated tote / bin for recycling and garbage collection. Avoid mixing garbage and recycling together in the same container.

Only recycle what is accepted (please see our website for a full list).

## All Other Items

Take any electronics to our e-waste drop off location at the Reeces Corners Public Works Yard (5819 Oil Heritage Road) or at Transco Recycling (387 McGregor Sideroad).

Building Materials (including toilets) can be brought to Transco Recycling (387 McGregor Side Road), Curran Recycling (526 McGregor Side Road) or Sevcon Recycling (940 Plank Road). Some charges may apply.

Hazardous Waste can be brought to Clean Harbour Canada (4090 Telfer Road). Clean Harbours offers a variety of Household Hazardous Waste Days, call 519-864-1021 for more information.

**NOTE: PLEASE DO NOT DUMP ANY GARBAGE, RECYCLING OR YARD WASTE IN THE WYOMING PUBLIC CEMETERY**



**WASTE COLLECTION UPDATES:**

**ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:**

Solid Household Waste includes general household garbage (kitchen garbage) and bulk items. If in doubt and you have questions, please call Marcotte 519-339-9988.

**Bulk items INCLUDED,  but are not limited to:**

- Large appliances
- Small metal items
- Water tanks
- Barbeques (no propane tank)
- Furniture
- Fridge/freezer/air conditioners (purged & tagged),
- Carpet (rolled & tied less than 4 feet in length)
- Box springs/mattresses, Bed frames
- Freon must be removed from refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners by a licensed technician and properly tagged.

**Bulk items NOT INCLUDED: **

- Kitchen & Bathroom cabinets / broken down wood items / wood
- Renovation Materials / Building Materials / Drywall / Shingles/ Flooring / doors / counter tops / Windows / Siding /
- Toilets, bath tubs, Sinks, Ceramics/tiles, Vanities
- Wooden Dog houses
- Wooden picnic tables / pallets / patio stones
- Tires / car rims
- Hazardous Waste / Propane tanks / Paint / lawnmower with gas in it / paint / fluorescent tubes / oil
- Car / Vehicle seats / boat seats / parts/ motors / bumpers /
- Vehicle Batteries
- Hot tubs / pool pumps / air compressors / water cooler
- Microwaves
- Human waste (feces / urine in pails)
- Cast iron items
- Concrete / Sand / Dirt / Ashes
