- Mouth Wash Bottles

### #2 Plastic (HDPE)

- Juice Containers
- Milk Jugs
- Laundry Soap Containers
- Shampoo Bottles
- Windshield Washer Containers (*only if no skull symbol present*)

### #4, #5, #6 Plastic

- Yogurt Containers
- Magarine Tubs & Lids
- Clean Flower Pots, Trays and Planters (*coded #2 and #5*)

All Plastic must be RINSED and **NO** food/oil residue can be left behind

**NO Caps or Lids**
