Plastics – NO CAPS – rinsed and no food/oil residue left behind #1 plastic (PETE)

Cooking Oil Bottles Peanut Butter Jars Dish Soap Bottles Mouth Wash Bottles
Clear Egg Cartons

#2 plastics (HDPE) - NO CAPS/LIDS

Juice Containers Milk Jugs Laundry Soap Containers Shampoo Bottles Windshield Washer Containers (Acceptable if there is no skull symbol; if there is skull symbol it goes to Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)).

#4, #5, & #6 plastics

Yogurt containers, margarine tubs & lids, clean flower pots, trays & planters (coded #2 and #5)

DON'T Recycle

Plastic Bags (e.g. grocery bag, clear bag, sandwich bags, plastic cling film, any plastic you can poke holes in, etc.)

Carbon, photographic, blueprint paper, cards (with foil, plastic, ribbon, or lamination) Flower pots, trays, planters, black take-out containers, anything with food/oil left in it.

Fall waste must be in paper bags and weigh no more than 50 pounds.

SIZE DOES MATTER

Please **DO NOT** recycle anything smaller than the size of a credit card as it jams the equipment.



All cardboard must be flattened, bundled and tied with string no bigger than 2'x2x4'
