All plastic containers stamped with a code 1 through 7
(check side or under items for the code)
Plastic grocery bags
Blister packaging
Plastic clam shell containers
Empty, dry metal paint cans
Cans (i.e. steel & aluminum food & pop cans)
Glass bottles & jars
Tetra Pak boxes
Milk and Juice Cartons
Aluminum Plates & Trays
(All items must be rinsed clean and must be empty)

Motor oil bottles
Aerosol cans
Broken glass
Mirrors
Plastic paint cans
Glass dishes
Ceramics

Biohazards

*Corrugated cardboard i.e. large packing boxes should be reduced to 2' x 2' x 18'' tied, bundled and placed beside the blue box. Box board i.e. cereal boxes and paper products smaller than this can be placed in the blue box, no need to tie or bundle.

*Glass, paper & cardboard should only be placed in the blue box or blue totes.

*Items must be clean and not contain any unused contents or leftover food.

*Recyclables placed at the curb in plastic bags cannot be collected. Please use either the blue box or blue totes
