SMOKE ALARMS ARE THE FIRST LINE OF DEFENSE IN FIRE ESCAPE PLANNING When was the last time you checked your alarms? Alarms should be checked and tested regularly by pressing the "test" button. Smoke alarms should also be dusted/ vacuumed every six (6) months.

HELP KEEP OUR ROADS IN THE BEST POSSIBLE CONDITION!

Landowners are encouraged to not spread grass and mud on the roadways:

- Damp grass blown onto a gravel road can clump together and, if graded into the gravel, can aid in creating potholes.
- Vegetation on the road can lead to organic debris getting into the gravel and slow drainage from the road.
- Tracked mud and damp cuttings blown onto a hard surface road can reduce the traction for vehicles, especially if they had to brake.
- Blowing cuttings toward the road creates a risk that a mower could shoot a stone or other debris at passing people or cars. While many residents are good about stopping when people or cars are passing by, it might just be easier to adjust your mowing practices to blow clippings away from the road.

OFF ROAD VEHICLES (ORVs) & ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATVs)

ORVs and ATVs are not permitted on roadways in Plympton-Wyoming, unless for permitted exemptions such as farmers conducting business. These vehicles are not allowed on the beaches or in/around beach accesses. Residents are asked to call the OPP for enforcement.

SOD REPAIR FROM SNOW PLOW DAMAGE

As lawns are starting to re-appear after the snow melts, you may notice damage to your lawn from plow blades. This happens more often when the ground doesn't completely freeze over the winter. Staff will repair damaged locations starting mid-April when the weather is appropriate for sod repair.
