

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Household Hazardous Wastes Days take place at the Clean Harbors Canada Inc. site, 4090 Telfer Road in St. Clair Township the last Saturdays of March, April, May, June, September, and October

Things to remember on Garbage Day

- Each household is allowed to place 1 large item a week out with your garbage.
- Ensure all items that contain Freon are tagged that the Freon has been removed by a licensed professional.
- Have all garbage and / or recycling out to the road before 7:00 a.m.
- Avoid mixing garbage and recycling together in the same container.
- Have a designated tote / bin for recycling and garbage collection.
- Only recycle what is accepted

****Take any electronics to our e-waste drop off location at the Reeces Corners Public Works Yard (5819 Oil Heritage Road) or at Transco Recycling (387 McGregor Sideroad).**

RECYCLING TRANSITION UPDATE

The Town of Plympton-Wyoming has entered into an agreement with Circular Materials effective July 1, 2023 while we transition to full producer responsibility.
