BILLING DUE DATES

2025—YEAR IN-REVIEW

2025 isn't over yet, but it has been a busy year for the Town!

Notable projects undertaken this year include:

- The completion of Confederation Line Phase 2 and completion of Michigan Line Phase 4
- The asphalt resurfacing of Blue Point Drive, Collingwood Street, Harris Point Drive and Dalrymple Street
- The rehabilitation of Fisher Line between Uttoxeter Road and Blue Heron
- Installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of Confederation and Broadway Street
- Installation of new playground equipment in Errol Woods and Blue Point
- The commencement of a new Parks and Recreation Master Plan
- The planned rehabilitation of the Wyoming Pool
- Implementation of an Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program

BLUE BOX RECYCLING PROGRAM UPDATE

Starting *January 1, 2026*, the Blue Box recycling program will transition from municipal management to a producer responsibility model under Ontario's new regulations. This means that the companies that produce packaging and paper products will now be fully responsible for the collection and management of these materials.

As a result, the municipality will no longer provide curbside Blue Box collection. Instead, recycling services will be operated by organizations acting on behalf of producers, such as Circular Materials. Further details on collection schedules, accepted materials, and how to access services will be shared by the service provider closer to the transition date.



HOW TO MITIGATE FLOODING & EROSION AS HEAVY RAINFALL EVENTS INCREASE

With an increase in significant rainfall events we can all participate in mitigating flooding and erosion occurrences. Even small measures can tremendously benefit our local environment and ecosystem.

- Keep downspouts and gutters free of debris
- Make sure downspouts are emptying on permeable ground that is graded away from structures
- Regularly keep storm drains on or adjacent to your property clear of debris
- Trim loose or dead branches from trees and shrubs
- Install rain gardens in low-lying areas of your yard to work as a natural drainage system
- Plant native shrubs, plants, and trees for canopy cover, water absorption, and to protect from erosion
- Increase and maintain native green spaces for natural absorption and filtration before rainwater drains to the lake, rivers, and drains
