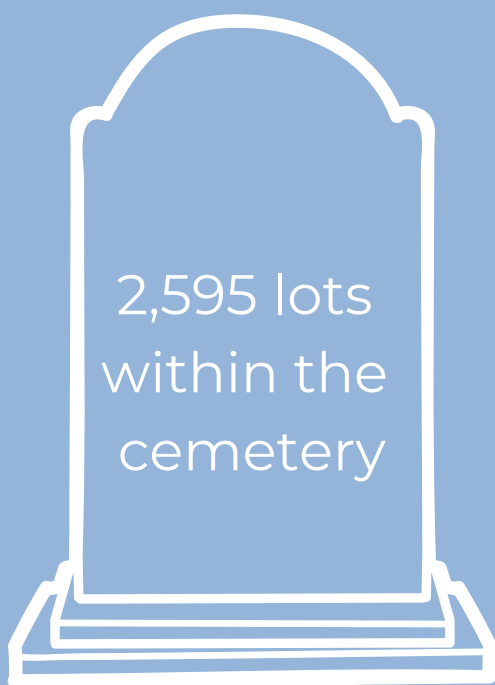
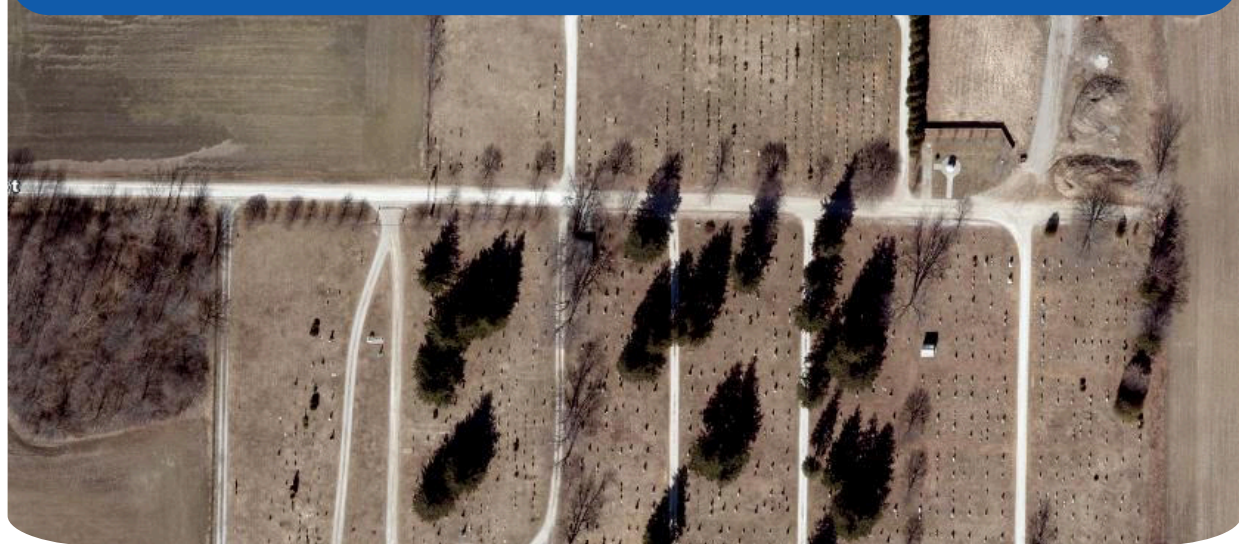

AVAILABLE LOTS

CREMATION / INFANT LOT

Dimensions - 3'6" x 5'

Capacity - 4 cremated remains **OR**
2 cremated remains and 1 infant-baby casket



FULL CEMETERY LOT

Dimensions - 3'6" x 10'

Capacity - 1 full casket burial and 1
cremated remain **OR**
4 cremated remains



COLUMBARIUM NICHE

Dimensions - 12" x 12" x 14"

Capacity - 2 cremated remains



The Cemetery Committee reserves the right to remove all flowers, plants, and wreaths when they become withered or unsightly.



The Cemetery reserves the right to regulate the articles placed on lots that pose a threat to the safety of right holders, visitors, employees, prevents the cemetery from performing general operations, or are not in keeping with the respect and dignity of the cemetery. Prohibited articles will be removed and disposed of without notification.

The Wyoming Public Cemetery is operated in accordance with the Funeral, Burial, and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) and the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO). The Cemetery is governed by the Wyoming Public Cemetery & Inactive Cemetery Committee.

MEMORIAL SERVICE IN HONOUR OF DECORATION DAY

Every year on the second Sunday of June the Wyoming Public Cemetery & Inactive Cemetery Committee hosts a Decoration Day Service. The service has recently featured a soloist, piper, and several local speakers. Visit www.plympton-wyoming.com/cedeteries for more information!

Decoration Day is a time honoured tradition where families visit the cemetery to pay respects to their loved ones by tidying up gravesites, cleaning cemetery memorials, and placing floral tributes. Decoration Day, a precursor to Remembrance Day, was once a nationally recognized day in Canada that commemorated our war dead.

BY-LAWS

The Wyoming Public Cemetery is governed by By-law 34 of 2024, being a By-law to provide for the Management and Control of Municipally owned Cemeteries in the Town of Plympton-Wyoming. This includes information on markers, monuments, interment contracts, and burials.
