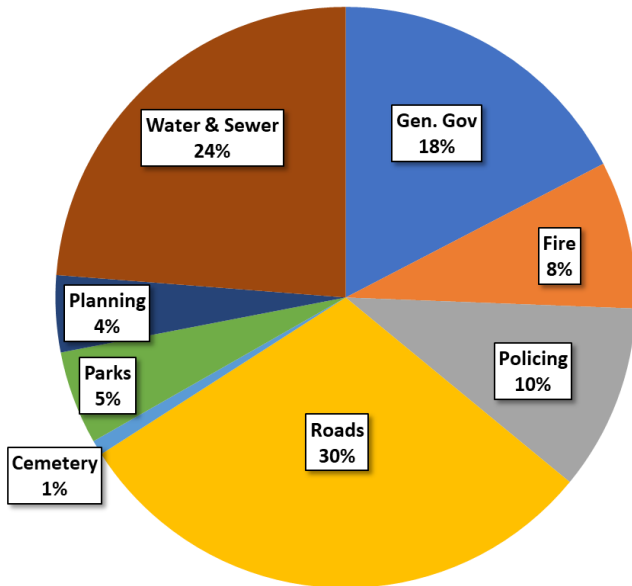

2025 CAPITAL EXPENSES

- Public Works Department replacement of fleet (tractor with mower, float trailer, pickup truck)

OPEN AIR BURNING

The Town of Plympton-Wyoming regulates open air burning, refer to our website to see the Open Air Burning By-Law: www.plympton-wyoming.com/en/my-plympton-wyoming/open-air-burning-and-permits.aspx

Social campfires no larger than 0.5 meters in diameter are permitted without permit.

Agricultural Open Air Burning requires a permit and is limited to daylight hours. Permits must be completed at the Plympton-Wyoming Municipal Office a minimum of two business days prior to the date of the proposed burn.

Municipal drains are an integral part of the landscape in Plympton-Wyoming. Please notify the Drainage Department of any repairs or maintenance requests for municipal drains. We are now preparing for open ditch cleanouts for this fall/winter (2025). 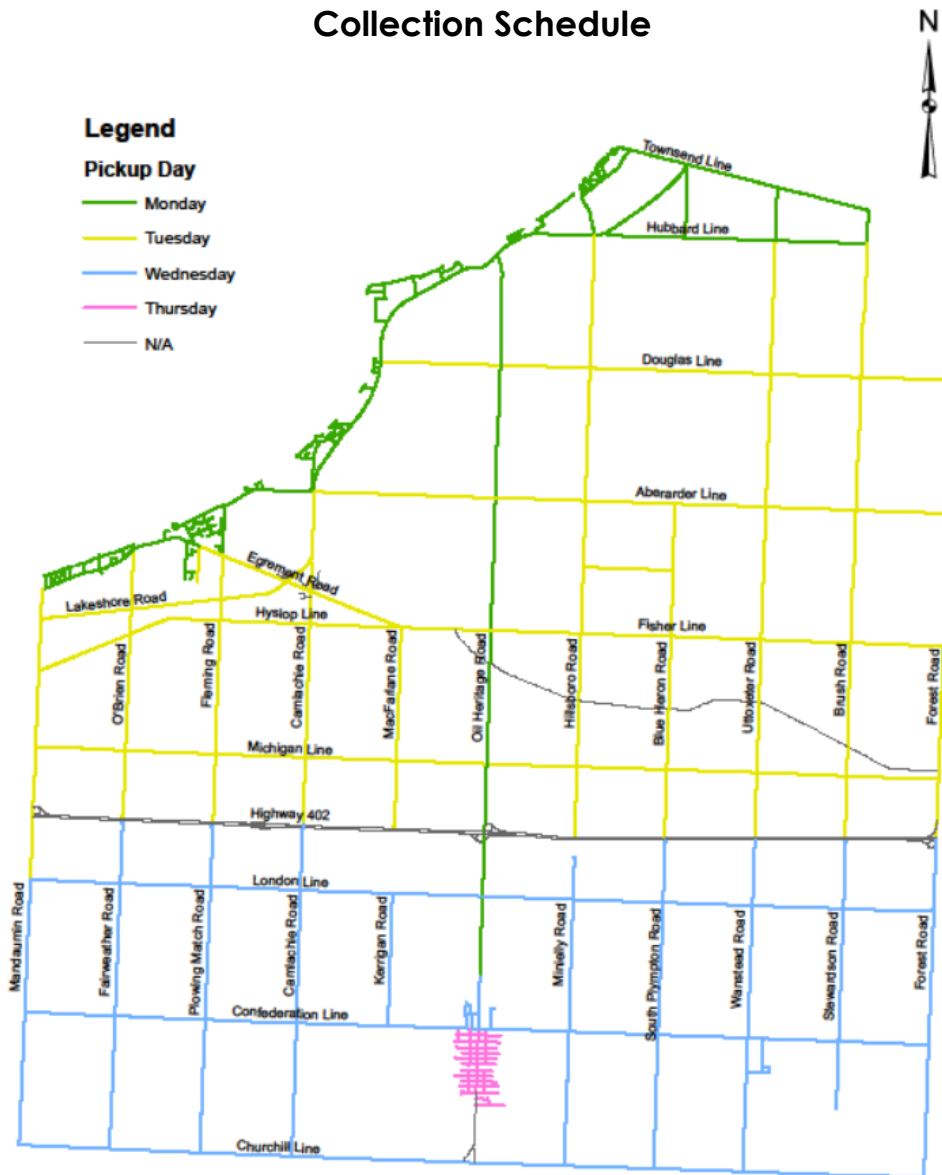

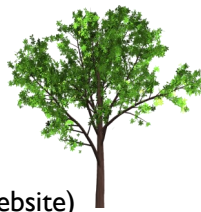
