

## NOTICE OF PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT RELATED TO ADDITIONAL RESIDENTIAL UNITS

**Take Notice** that on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming passed By-law 98 of 2025. A zoning By-law Amendment to the Town of Plympton-Wyoming Comprehensive Zoning By-law, pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

**The purpose and effect:** This is a Town-initiated housekeeping amendment that affects all lands in the Town of Plympton-Wyoming as generally itemized below:

- 1. Amend and add to table of contents.
- 2. Amend, add and remove definitions.
- 3. Amend and add general provisions for Additional Residential Units.
- 4. Amend and add Additional Residential Units as Permitted Uses in specific Zones, accordingly.

This Notice and By-law 98 of 2025 are available for inspection between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays at the Municipal Office at 546 Niagara Street, Wyoming, ON. ## **Appeals**

Take notice that an appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect to all or part of this Zoning By-law Amendment may be made by filing a notice of appeal with the Town Clerk either via the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <a href="https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service">https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service</a> by selecting Plympton-Wyoming (Town of) as the Approval Authority or by mail to 546 Niagara St, Wyoming, ON, N0N 1T0, no later than 4:30 p.m. on November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The appeal fee of \$1,100 can be paid online through e-file or by certified cheque/money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario. If you wish to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) or request a fee reduction for an appeal, forms are available from the OLT website at <a href="www.olt.gov.on.ca">www.olt.gov.on.ca</a>. If the e- file portal is down, you can submit your appeal to EKwarciak@plympton-wyoming.ca. Upon filing of an appeal an additional OLT Appeal Administration Fee of \$300.00 is due to the Town of Plympton-Wyoming.

A specified person or public body may appeal a zoning by-law to the Ontario Land Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the By- law was passed, the person or body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council, or, in the opinion of the Ontario Land Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
