SUBJECT MATTER: MOVING OF BUILDINGS ON TOWN ROADS

If any party wants to move a building or any other oversize structure on municipal roads, the following steps should be taken:

- 1. The contractor/owner approaches the municipality with the plan of work including size of a building and a proposed route.
- 2. Municipal Road Authority will assess the plan and either approve it or designate an alternate route if required.
- The contractor/owner is to provide a copy of liability insurance of up to \$5,000,000.00 to cover any road/structures damaged.
- 4. Municipality to issue a building moving permit if approved.
